

Klein Oak High School Boys' Basketball Parents' Booster Club  
General Meeting Minutes  
December 17, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 6:40 p.m. by President Jerry Fabian. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

The financial report was discussed. Treasurer Don Loisel noted that revenue from this year's Freshman Tournament was double that of last year. Lucille Rowley is selling the excess candy from the Tournament out of the salon. The Booster Club gave \$4,200 to the school for uniforms and warmups. The current balance is \$9,282.33.

Vice President Robert Herr next reported on the Golf Tournament. Revenue from this year's Tournament was \$4,200 compared to \$2,400 last year. Robert noted that it was a great success and appreciated all those who helped out. Jerry publicly thanked Robert for all of his time and effort in making it a great success.

Jerry noted and thanked all those who helped with Meet the Panthers and the Freshman Tournament. He noted that the officials complemented us on the hospitality room, and noted those establishments that donated to the cause – Chili's, Buffalo Wild Wings, HEB, Kroger, and Wal-Mart. He also thanked NHS and Lucille and her Cosmetology students for helping out as well.

Becky Demarais discussed spirit item sales. Spirit items will be sold at Tuesday night home games January 8 and 15. Hoodies and tee shirts are available, and she is taking orders for polos and bleacher cushions.

Edie Sloan noted that Lenny's Sub Shop would provide game day meals for \$5 each with a minimum of six orders. There is free delivery if called in by 10:30 on the day of the game. It can be paid weekly or for the season. Jerry and Edie will coordinate.

Jerry next discussed the Shoot-a-thon on January 16 at 1 p.m. He noted that the form had already been sent home and that it raised more than \$5,000 last year. The pledge money must be in by January 31.

Coach Martin discussed 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade nights and is going to coordinate halftime entertainment. He'd like to have a pep rally on January 7 or 8. Senior Night will be pre-game on February 12, and will be coordinated by Jerry.

LeeAnn Schultz next discussed the Banquet scheduled for March 5 at 6:30 p.m. at Shirley Acres. She is having a meeting on Thursday, January 3, at 6:30 for anyone who wants to help with the banquet. This includes people to decorate, check off names, video, etc. Jerry will post the meeting time and place on the website. All Banquet information will be out by January 14, and Panther Paws ads will be due by February 8.

Coach Martin noted that the coaches are learning his system. He is trying to develop a winning mentality, and reiterated that playing time is earned in practice.
