

Klein Oak High School Boys' Basketball Parents' Booster Club
General Meeting Minutes
January 14, 2008

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by President Jerry Fabian. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

Everyone was reminded that the Shoot-a-Thon was Wednesday at 1p.m. The boys would eat lunch and then go participate. In the past, it has been the largest fundraiser, with the funds used to offset the expenses of the banquet.

The Treasurer's report was distributed and discussed. Treasurer Don Loisel noted that there is about \$2,000 more in the bank now than at the beginning of the year. However, he also noted that some banquet expenses are still forthcoming. There are currently 23 families that have joined the Booster Club. He also noted that he is working on getting the Sales Tax Return and Form 990 filed.

Next, Becky Demarais discussed the spirit item situation. It was decided that the Booster Club would not sell stadium seats. Volunteers would sell tee shirts during the remaining home games.

Lee Ann Schultz noted that the invitations for the Banquet had been done. February 22 is the deadline to make reservations. The program will consist of a profile of varsity players, with team pictures of the sub-varsity teams. There will also be an acknowledgement of the administration, coaches, and Booster Club members in the program. Ad sales are still needed. Next year the program will also serve as a media guide to be used for the whole season.

A motion was approved to provide \$100 for cake and drinks for Junior High Night. It was also decided that the backpacks in stock will be given away to the Junior High players in attendance. The last home game, Krimmel v. Hildebrandt, will be played at Oak, with the players' names being announced. A motion was also approved to provide a memorial contribution in the amount of \$100 in honor of Gary Nelson's mother to the Church in Mt. Vernon, Ohio.

Coach Martin reviewed the practice schedule for the upcoming week. He stressed that the won-loss record for the sub-varsity was not as important to him as seeing improvement. He also noted that we are in a good district, with both Klein Forest and Klein Collins being state-ranked. Finally, there was not enough interest in Lenny's Sub Shop sandwich order/delivery, so the idea was nixed.

Jerry noted that a nominating committee will be formed to nominate officers for next year. The slate will be presented at the Banquet with a vote to be held at the April meeting.
