

Klein Oak High School Boys' Basketball Parents' Booster Club  
General Meeting Minutes  
September 10, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by President Jerry Fabian.

Coach Martin distributed the basketball information packet. Treasurer Loisel distributed the financial report and budget. President Fabian explained that there would be no approvals tonight because there was not a quorum present.

Becky Demarais noted that both a "Panther Pride" and "Basketball" tee shirt were available to purchase. Hoodies would be ordered at a later date, and polo shirts would be available through special order only with an option for embroidery.

Vice President Herr explained that the Golf Tournament would be October 21 at 1 p.m. at Gleannloch Pines. He noted that he needed commitment and participation from parents, players and/or sponsors and would send out an email to that effect. He noted the \$100/player (\$75/student) fee included dinner afterward, and that prizes for various contests would be awarded. He noted that players could sign up online or via mail. He also asked Coach Martin for an updated email list from all players.

The Booster Club will be selling concessions at the Freshman Tournament November 30 – December 1, with all proceeds coming to the Club. Lucille Rowley and her Cosmetology students will be covering the concession stand, but assistance from parents/businesses is also needed.

Treasurer Loisel presented the budget which is to be approved at the next meeting. He noted that the \$4200 "Gift to School" is per Coach Martin's request for new Varsity uniforms and travel warmups.

Coach Martin asked for the continued support and help of the Booster Club officers and asked for more members. His staff this year includes Freshman Coach Brumfield, Coach Clancy, Coach Crawford, with another coach yet to be hired. Coach Martin discussed his background and experience, and noted that one of his goals is to bring enthusiasm for the basketball programs at Klein Oak, as well as Hildebrandt and Krimmel. He announced that the first cut had already been made, and expected the players to maintain good grades and a neat appearance. He also announced that open gym would be on Tuesdays and Fridays from 3:30-5:00, and strength and conditioning would be available Monday through Thursday from 3:00-3:45. He noted that the schedule would soon be finalized, distributed, and posted to the website. He next discussed his plans for organizing two AAU teams to compete in tournaments next summer, and the possibility of holding summer basketball camps. He asked that players make prior arrangements if they needed to go home with parents and not ride the team bus.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55.
