

## SUMMARY OF QUALIFICATIONS

Joey Martin has been the Head Basketball Coach at Big Spring High School for this past year and the previous eight years at T.K. Gorman High School. He has had **nine winning seasons** with an overall record of 219 wins and 75 losses. He has had **four state final four appearances** and six district championships. He has earned **Coach of the Year honors seven times**. Prior to T.K. Gorman he was the Associate Head Coach at East Texas Baptist University in Marshall, TX. where his coaching responsibilities also included weight training and conditioning, recruiting student athletes, skill development, scheduling, and tutoring.

Martin's plan for success, his passion, determination, and his style of play re-energized the Big Spring Steer's fan base. The attendance and enthusiasm more than tripled the previous years at Big Spring High School. His work with the student fan club has filled the entire student section at every home game at Steer Gymnasium.

Coach Martin has drastically improved Big Spring's schedule since arriving in West Texas also. With the likes of # **3Lubbock Estacado, Midland Lee (5A), district champions Midland High (5A), #1 Abilene Wylie, district champions Midland Greenwood, Amarillo Tascosa (5A), Lubbock High (5A), and two time defending state champions #1 Dallas South Oak Cliff (4A)**, Martin has taken a program that won 15 games total in the previous four years before Martin's arrival and turned it into a competitive program competing against the best the state has to offer.

Prior to coming to Big Spring, Martin built a powerhouse basketball program at T.K. Gorman competing against the likes of Dallas Skyline (5A), John Tyler (5A), Whitehouse (4A), Shreveport Byrd (5A), Longview Pine Tree (4A), and many other highly ranked schools.

Another tangible sign of Martin's impact on his basketball program is the money raised to improve the facilities at both T.K. Gorman and Big Spring High school. He was instrumental in getting a \$180,000 renovation to Steer Gym's boy's locker rooms and coaching offices. At T.K. Gorman, he guided the renovations of new locker rooms, new score clocks, score table, new gym floor, and his biggest accomplishment, air conditioning Haddad Gymnasium. Overall Coach Martin has proven the ability to improve the facilities and help raise money to support the program.

During Joey Martin's ten year coaching, he has coached over 15 players that went on to play Division I basketball and many others to Division II, Jr. college, and NAIA programs. To name a few: Chris Low (Arizona St.), Jason Horton (Missouri), Ed Moore (Tyler JC/Gardener Webb), Chris Moore (Tulane), Stephen Verwers (Hawaii), Kelvin Williams (Sam Houston), David Fisher (New Mexico St.), Drew Kaufman (Texas Tech), LaKeithan Malone (Arkansas Little Rock), and the latest, John Huber (Colorado School of Mines).

He is actively involved on faculty, athletic, and student affairs committees. He has proven athletic administration skills that include: Budgeting, Travel Planning, Staffing, Scheduling, Academic Standards, Public Relations, and Recreational Programs. Joey Martin is a member of the Texas Association of Basketball Coaches (TABC) and the Texas High School Coaches Association (THSCA).

Joey Martin is a ('97) graduate of Stephen F. Austin State University where he played Division I basketball for Lumberjack's coaches Ned Fowler and Derrick Allister.

He is a ('92) graduate of Troup High School where he was the captain of the 2A State Championship Basketball Team. He was 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-State in basketball, as well as making the Academic All-State team in high school. Martin also excelled in both baseball and football. He was a two time 1<sup>st</sup> team all district pitcher and 1<sup>st</sup> team all district in three positions in football; quarterback, free safety, and punter.

Joey Martin is married; he and his wife Tami have four beautiful children, Taylor who is twelve years old, twins Samuel and Savanna who are seven years old, and the newest addition Houston who was born on January 11, 2007. He is publicly active in his church, in other services to his community, and especially in support to the lives of his wife and four children.
